We have so far reached agreements with 9 journals to be our partners. These include:

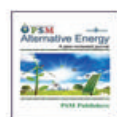
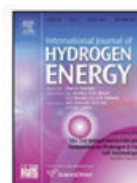
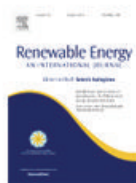
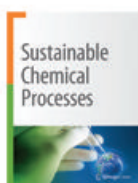
